

Tactical Karta Gauntlets

These Tactical Stealth Gauntlets are the business when engaged competitively or for fieldwork. A thick reinforced 300gm twill fabric with an internal crossed woven framework for each gauntlet, giving strength, durability, and peace of mind when worn. Eleven 3mm thick high grade octagonal Aluminium karlta for maximum protection is given for each gauntlet, against soft tissue damage to the forearms, from sharp object or bladed weaponry. A must have item for any avid collector or collection.

These gauntlets are Sageo cord laced, and tied looping around the back of the elbow and knotted securely in place. The Karlta plates are tactically place to avoid cuts to the forearm diagonally, face on or Kote strikes to the wrists.

A/ Your Gauntlets should arrive laced up and ready to slip each arm through. Untie the Bow, loosen the Sageo Cord and slide each arm through in tern keeping the Sageo or cord under the forearm as you slide each Gauntlet into position.

B/ This section needs close attention in order to ensure the stability of each Gauntlet. Cross each Sageo cord at the fold of the elbow joint, then bring both ends round the back of the elbow, above the main joint. Lifting your arm laterally will make this process easier if tying on your own.

Now make a simple overhand knot with one hand pulling securely by placing the other end of the Sageo Cord between your teeth. Make sure at this point that the cord is over the elbow joint as in (image 3). You can now either use a second overhand knot, or finish with a Bow knot
